

Important announcement for all drivers pit crews and spectators attending our racing events at ringwood raceway Starting from Saturday 26th September until further notice .

After listening to government guidelines and to be in line with those imposed changes it is now compulsory for all patrons customers and race crews that face coverings will now be mandatory at ringwood raceway. There is also the continued rule of 6 in place meaning 1 can meet 5 2 can meet 4 3 can meet 3 4 can meet 2 5 can meet 1 6 can not mix with 1 So this means the same family watching from the same household over 6 is fine. Friends can talk with friends and race goers can help other race goers in maximum of 6 drivers will be responsible to making sure your bubble and help does not exceed 6 at any one time. Spectators are also reminded that you can attend the racing but must make sure that you do not exceed standing with friends in groups of more than 6 Anyone not wearing face coverings and not adhering to rule of 6 will be asked to do so by members of staff in order to comply with new government guidelines. It is important that you all attend knowing this and adhere to our rules so that racing can continue at the raceway. We cannot risk being outside of the law and it is imperative that we all do our part to keeping racing going. There is also a 2 mtr distancing rule in place whilst spectating and in pit areas. Racing gates open at 2pm and racing from 6pm stay safe and we will see you this coming Saturday guys Thanks Craig
